


# Bridge Update

Thanks to GreenFest 2014 ticket sales and generous donations from our sponsors, the Greenbelt Alliance, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD), and the Lake Ray Roberts Equestrian Trail Association (LRRETA) have successfully raised the funds necessary to construct a bridge that will cross a deep trail washout on the Greenbelt between FM 455 and FM 428. This railed pedestrian and equestrian walkway will be 60-70 feet long and will provide access to a previously inaccessible 4.5 miles of trail. The LRRETA grant, which estimated the cost for this bridge and other trail improvements to be approximately \$165,000, required the local public to raise 20% or \$33,000. We would like to thank our sponsors, GreenFest 2014 attendees, and countless other helping hands for enabling us to successfully raise this money! Bridge construction is currently underway and should be completed in late 2015.

## New Texas Horse Park



LRRETA is focused on equestrian trails around the N Fork of the Trinity -- equally exciting things are going on around the South Fork also! The new Texas Horse Park opened March 28, 2015 -- see attached Master Plan.

The Master Plan of the Texas Horse Park consists of Phase 1, with a \$12 million investment from the City of Dallas and future phases to be funded privately. THP sits in the middle of the largest urban forest in America -- the 6,000 acre Trinity Forest, 12 minutes south of downtown Dallas, off I-45.

THP has 600 acres for future growth, with the initial phase consisting of 2 covered arenas and 3 barns for Equest Therapeutic Horsemanship and River Ranch Education Charities. For future phases, we need to raise private funds for the Equestrian Center of Texas, Indoor Arena, Cross Country Course, Driving Course, Polo Fields, Collegiate Equestrian Center, etc. With your continued support, the Texas Horse Park has the potential to become an international competition venue for equestrian sports.
